III. Council Structure **20 min**

- Subcommittees: In general, GC will operate with three standing subcommittees: Awards Subcommittee (makes recommendations for all graduate student fellowships), CRF Subcommittee (reviews and makes recommendations regarding all graduate courses), and Policy Review Subcommittee (reviews all campus and systemwide policies).
- CCGA Lead Reviewers: For the review of proposals to establish stand-alone graduate programs a GC member will be assigned as the lead reviewer. The CCGA lead reviewers coordinate the review of a specific CCGA Proposal from the moment the proposal is received by the Graduate Council. All Lead Reviewers are assigned as needed.

IV. GC Conflict of Interest Policy **5 min**

Background: Last year, CRE and DivCo decided to “test run” the UC Riverside model of having each standing committee compose a COI statement (or equivalent) at the start of each academic year. GC drafted and approved a COI statement that was uploaded to the Senate website.

Background: Given the complexity of the UCM CCGA proposal review process, it is critical to define steps in it and develop a timeline for it, and identify reviewers so that programs have a chance of CCGA approval this next academic year. GC developed a review rubric based on the updated CCGA Handbook.
