B. Draft General Education Program Bylaws

The General Education Executive Committee (GEEC) has proposed permanent Bylaws for the GE program. The program has been governed under a set of interim Bylaws that will expire in December, 2019. Following extensive deliberation, the GEEC is proposing to adopt the interim Bylaws as permanent, with some modifications that remove outdated information (e.g. references to the GE Subcommittee of UGC), clarify the roles of the GEEC Chair and Members, and change the current requirement of a two-thirds vote of approval for revisions to the GE Program. On September 26, the Bylaws were distributed to Senate and Non-Senate Faculty with a request for comments by October 14. A vote of the faculty is scheduled to take place in early November.

Chair Leppert invited the Senate to comment on the proposed Bylaws.
