# Minutes of Meeting October 11, 2017

Pursuant to call, the Committee on Rules and Elections met at 11:00 AM on October 11<sup>th</sup>, 2017 in Room 232 of the Kolligian Library, Chair Lin Tian presiding.

## I. Chair's Report - Lin Tian

Chair Tian welcomed new members. She identified the work and focal areas of the Committee on Rules and Elections (CRE) for the upcoming year, and discussed the continued work for CRE with regard to the Reference Document on Voting Rights. This document provides recommendations on voting polices specific to UC Merced. CRE will discuss and establish next steps.

#### II. Carry-over Business from AY 16-17

### A. CRE Reference Document on Voting Rights

The purpose of the CRE Reference Document on Voting Rights is to serve as a reference tool for the University of California Merced community with questions regarding voting rights. The Recommended Voting Policies in Academic Personnel Cases was submitted to DivCo during the Spring of 2017 for review. After receiving comments from DivCo, CRE will draft a response addressing those comments with the intention of resubmitting prior to the end of the Fall 2017 semester, if possible.

**ACTION ITEM:** Formulate and circulate a draft response to the CRE committee members.

#### B. Review of the proposed Honors Regulations Revisions

The CRE unanimously approved the proposed <u>Honors Regulation Revisions (SR 640)</u>, specific to <u>Part II. Section 4</u>: the addition of Subsection D. Honors Programs.

**ACTION ITEM:** Draft approval memo for the proposed Honors Regulations Revisions and transmit approval to the Divisional Council.

### III. New Business: Proposed Bylaw Changes to the Duties of the Undergraduate Council

The CRE unanimously approved the Proposed Bylaw Changes to the Duties of the Undergraduate Council.
