# A. Extension to establish a new Non-Degree Certificate in Child Development and Care (CDC) – Anna Song

Members are asked to review and comment on a proposal from University Extension to establish a new Non-Degree Certificate in Child Development and Care (CDC). The policy governing the establishment of a non-degree program by Extension is <a href="here">here</a>. As per section II.C. of the policy, the Senate is asked to consider the following when reviewing a proposal for a non-degree program put forth by Extension:

Senate Committee members should ask questions if there are concerns about the credibility of a content area, intended audience, or selection of courses to be included in a non-degree program, or resource impacts on existing (non-Extension) academic programs.

## B. Proposed Revisions to Bylaws II.IV.4.A - LASC Membership - Chair Viney

Members are asked to review and comment on the proposed revisions to <u>Senate Bylaw II.IV.4.A</u> addressing the membership of the <u>Committee for Scholarly and Library Communication</u> (LASC). The proposed revisions increase the faculty membership of the committee to seven from four, through the addition of three at-large members, no more than one from each school. The intent is to enrich LASC with the perspectives and expertise of faculty who are significantly interested in

library matters, but who are not concurrently serving on another Senate Committee. The revisions are not proposed to address any changes to the committee's work load or charge; these remain as they were.
