VII. Request from Graduate Council (GC) - <u>Proposed Policy for</u>
<u>Undergraduate/Graduate Hybrid Degree Programs</u> - Alejandro Gutierrez and Heather Bortfeld

In AY 21-22, a proposal for a combined Bachelor's and Master's program was submitted to the Senate; however, there was no UCM policy in place for establishing and reviewing such programs. GC has worked to develop a policy, linked above, modeled after that of

<u>UC Riverside</u> and invites UGC to review the proposed policy in terms of undergraduate education.

GC also invites UGC to review GC's Procedures for Submitting Proposals for Graduate Programs, and Undergraduate/Graduate Hybrid Degree Programs, as UGC is included in the review process for Undergraduate/Graduate Hybrid Degree Programs, as described beginning on page 2 of the document.

On January 23, 2023, the Policy Subcommittee reviewed the proposed policy and the revisions to GC's Procedures for Submitting Proposals for Graduate Programs, and Undergraduate/Graduate Hybrid Degree Programs. Their recommended revisions on the proposed policy are available here. The subcommittee did not recommend any revisions to GC's Procedures for Submitting Proposals for Graduate Programs, and Undergraduate/Graduate Hybrid Degree Programs.
