## VI. <u>Proposed Revisions to the Policy for Establishing Hybrid Undergraduate/Graduate Degree</u> <u>Programs</u> – Chair Abatzoglou – 12:40pm – 12:55pm

In Fall 2024, a faculty member contacted the Senate and GC leadership regarding a potential exception to GC's <u>Policy for Establishing Hybrid Undergraduate/Graduate Degree Programs (HDP)</u> to allow for an increase in the number of units from the graduate level course work to be counted toward undergraduate degree requirements.

The GC Analyst and Chair Abatzoglou proposed the following revisions noted in bold, underlined font, and available in the documents linked below.

## Page 2, number 5 of the policy:

"HDP programs allow for 12 units of graduate level coursework to count toward undergraduate degree requirements. Each HDP program sets its upper limit of graduate level units which can be counted towards the Bachelor's degree, but the upper limit should not exceed 12 units, **unless otherwise approved by exception by the Graduate Council (GC)**."
