These revisions are requested by Divisional Council, following its April 24, 2017 endorsement of UGC's approval of *The Proposal for an English Honors Program*. At that time, Divisional Council noted that the Honors Program can be established, and students enrolled to graduate with honors, but that the program's desire to award High Honors and Highest Honors requires revisions to the Division's Regulations. There is no lead reviewer among Senate committees.
