A. UC Transfer Admission Proposal

The Board of Admissions and Relations with Schools (BOARS) was tasked to revisit the University's transfer admission guarantee policy following UC's entering into an MOU with the California Community Colleges (CCCs) in spring of 2018. Senate committees are now invited to review the proposal from BOARS.

B. Proposed Revision to Senate Regulation 636.E

The revisions seek to address equity concerns related to how UC students are allowed to satisfy the University's Entry Level Writing Requirement . The revisions were proposed by the Santa Barbara Division and have been endorsed by the University Committee on Preparatory Education.
