C. Proposed Revisions to Merced Division Bylaws - LASC Membership

## VI. Systemwide Review Item – Patti LiWang

A. <u>Proposed revisions to APM 230</u> – Visiting Professional Researchers and Visiting Project Scientists The proposed revisions reflect changes made to comply with a stipulated agreement between the University of California and the International Union, United Automobile, Aerospace and Agricultural Implement Workers of America (UAW) in recognition of the Researchers-Academic Unit formation. On March 22, 2019, the UC and the UAW entered into an agreement to recognize the Academic Researchers United/UAW as the exclusive representative of a unit of employees as defined in the Stipulation. Pursuant to the stipulation, who qualifies as a Visitor in terms of the in-unit titles in the RA Unit has changed.
