III. UC Merced Space Planning and Allocation Board (SPA Board) Pg. 8-13 On February 16, Provost Peterson and newly-named Special Assistant to the Chancellor (former VC for Planning & Budget) Feitelberg issued the attached memo, outlining plans to empanel a campus wide space and allocation board. This policy requires that all UAS operations are performed in a manner that mitigates risks to safety, security, and privacy, and ensures compliance with the Federal Aviation Administration Modernization and Reform Act of 2012 (Public Law 112–95) and all applicable laws.
