A. Proposed Revisions to Presidential Policy on Sustainable Practices The revised policy, together with a summary of the revisions from UCOP, are available at the above link.

B. Proposed Presidential Policy on Integrated Pest Management
 The proposed policy, together with a cover letter from UCOP, are available at the above link.

The policy is newly proposed to address the following key issues:

- The issuance of the Integrated Pest Management ("IPM") Policy intends to establish the University of California's requirements for the implementation of an IPM Program at every UC location as recommended by the UC Herbicide Task Force formed by former President Napolitano with support from the Regents.
- Exemptions to the policy include the use of pesticides in research, the use of antimicrobials for hygienic purposes (e.g., disinfecting sprays or wipes, pool treatments, and drinking water treatments), and the use of chemicals for the purpose of sterilizing medical products or equipment.

**Action:** CoR to identify a lead reviewer. The lead reviewer's comments will be discussed at the November 1 CoR meeting. CoR's comments on due by 5:00 pm on Thursday, November 4.

C. Proposed revisions to APM-759 (Leaves of Absence/Other Leaves Without Pay) The revised policy, together with a summary of the revisions from UCOP, are available at the above link.

In May 2021, the Regents Working Group on Innovation Transfer and Entrepreneurship recommended in its final report that APM-759 be revised to explicitly state that a leave without pay can be used for innovation and entrepreneurship pursuits. The proposed revisions to APM-759 are responsive to the Regents Working Group recommendations.
