UCOP has released the UC Climate Action Research Initiative 2022. This is a one-time opportunity to apply for approximately \$85M in state funds.

Funds will be allocated through Seed Awards (\$500k-\$2M) and Matching Grants \$2M-\$10M) and must address California climate action priorities. Proposals from early career faculty and from early career non-faculty researchers with PI status are encouraged. Inclusion of training opportunities for graduate students and post-doctoral fellows in both award types are strongly encouraged.
