V. ORU Policy

a. In AY 13-14, the Senate approved a <u>comprehensive set of policies</u> related to the establishment and review of research units. In fall 2014, the VCORED drafted a <u>separate policy on ORUs</u> and the Provost/EVC drafted a <u>separate policy on Centers</u>. In March 2015, after review by Senate committees, Division Council sent a memo to the VCORED with a <u>list of suggested revisions</u> to his policy on ORUs and a memo with <u>suggested revisions</u> to the Provost/EVC for his policy on Centers. The Provost/EVC has not yet submitted a revised policy in response to Senate comments.

Action requested: COR to incorporate the VCORED's policy on Centers into the Senate's comprehensive policy on research units.
