Subcommittees

In general, GC will operate with three standing subcommittees: Awards Subcommittee (makes recommendations for all graduate student fellowships), CRF Subcommittee (reviews and makes recommendations regarding all graduate courses), and Policy Review Subcommittee (reviews all campus and systemwide policies).

CCGA Lead Reviewers

For the review of proposals to establish stand-alone graduate programs a GC member will be assigned as the lead reviewer. The CCGA lead reviewers coordinate the review of a specific CCGA Proposal from the moment the proposal is received by the Graduate Council. All Lead Reviewers are assigned as needed.

#### VIII. Proposed Course Buyout Policy
