Systemwide Regulations- Article 1. General Provisions 760. The value of a course in units shall be reckoned at the rate of one unit for three hours' work per week per term on the part of a student, or the equivalent.
- The Registrar has provided a report showing one year of graduate courses and associated contact and credit hours.
- VI. MA/MS Requirements**
295-299 courses: At its meeting on December 7, GRC discussed clarifying whether graduate research units, the 295-299 series, count towards the 200 series courses. GRC requested input from the graduate groups and received one response. However, revisions and/or adherence to the policy would have major implications for students as the Dean of the Graduate Division often has to grant exceptions to the current policy.
The Senate analyst was asked to compile other UC campus' minimum requirements for GRC consideration.

Action: Discuss and make recommendation on the MA/MS requirements.
